Event synopsis

Suffolk Design is a county wide, long term programme of engagement and behavioural change across and within local authorities looking to embed high quality design into future developments. As part of our initial work we are hosting a series of events to engage stakeholders as we seek to provide access to technical data, policies and design tools they need to design quality buildings and spaces. We want to inspire people with the beauty of Suffolk's environment and the best of architecture, landscape design and place-making from the county. This is the 20th event in our series and focuses on how Suffolk can consider security in the design of future developments.

The National Planning Policy Framework places greater emphasis on "creating places where crime and disorder, and the fear of crime, do not undermine the quality of life or community cohesion and resilience." The Suffolk Design Security workshop will feature a guest speaker from the Centre of Protection for the National Infrastructure (CPNI) and include the input of the Design out Crime Team from Suffolk Constabulary. The workshop will focus on security threats and show the range of countermeasures that can be blended in to the streetscape to mitigate these threats. The workshop will use the ideas from the 'Designing Out Crime', residential design guide, and develop these as to how they can be embedded. A Q&A session will provide attendees the opportunity to question and discuss how to best put the countermeasures into practice and work with stakeholders to achieve 'Security in Design'.
